REGISTRATION FEES AND POLICIES

Teams can be of any size. Fees are based on the date of registration, the number of teams registered under the same advisor, and the number of people per team (Advisors + Co-Advisors + Team Leaders + Students).

- o Refer to the table below for team fees, discounts for early registration, discounts, and fees for additional members per team.
- o Payment. The Advisor will pay by credit card through the <u>WERC Team Site</u>. Contact us to make other payment arrangements (werc@nmsu.edu)
- o Registration fees will not be refunded, except for unavoidable circumstances. In that case, the team will be reimbursed for the fees paid minus the team's portion of expenses incurred at the point they exit the contest, including the cost of materials ordered for your team and the cost to ship items to your team, if applicable.

^{*}If at least one member of a team is an IEEE member, that team will receive a \$50 discount. Please encourage your students to join as well, since IEEE sponsors the WERC IEEE Conference and publication in *Xplore*. A student membership is only \$32. Join IEEE.

GOOGLE FORM

The registration system does not accommodate some of the information we need from each participant. Therefore, WERC will send each registrant a separate form (such as a Google form) to gather the additional information we need. These include:

- Meals: WERC provides to all teams, advisors, and judges a Welcome Dinner on Sunday evening, lunch on Monday and Tuesday, a Taco Bar on Tuesday evening, and an Awards Banquet on Wednesday.
 - → Dietary preferences and restrictions: Please note that our caterer serves only chicken, beef, cheese, and vegan dishes at the contest. We never serve pork.
 - → If we are able to accommodate your needs, we will email instructions for working with our caterers during the contest.
 - → If we cannot safely accommodate your dietary restrictions, you will need to arrange your own meals in Las Cruces. We will notify those affected. Your safety is our top priority, but some dietary requirements (e.g., Halal, Kosher, or severe allergies) may exceed our caterer's capabilities.
- o **T-shirt size** (for everyone) and **Jacket size** (for Advisors).
- o Demographic information, year in school, plans after graduation.
- o A survey of student confidence, skills, etc.
- o **Emergency contact information:** Make sure this is up to date when you arrive at the contest.
- o **Media Release.** You give permission for WERC to post your image or name in photos, videos, and news releases.

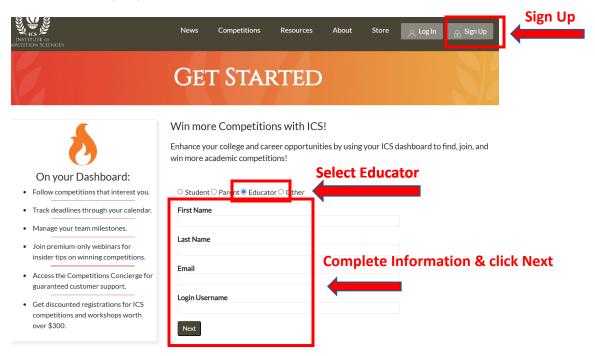
TEAM REGISTRATION PROCESS

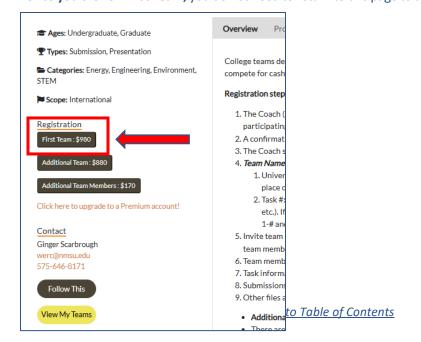
Visit the ICS Contact Us page if you encounter any issues with your registration.

Create Account:

- 1. **Sign Up for an account** . Provide name, email, username, confirm age (13+), and agree to ICS terms. You must be logged in to register for the contest.
- 2. Select the Basic (Free) account.



- Keep track of the number of teams you are going to register: First team and additional teams.
- Keep track of the number of people on each team. Please enter "Additional Team Members if any of your teams have more than 5 students or co-advisors on them. You, as the Advisor, will be the sixth person on the First team.
- Once you click on First Team, you do not need to return to this page to add more teams or more members.

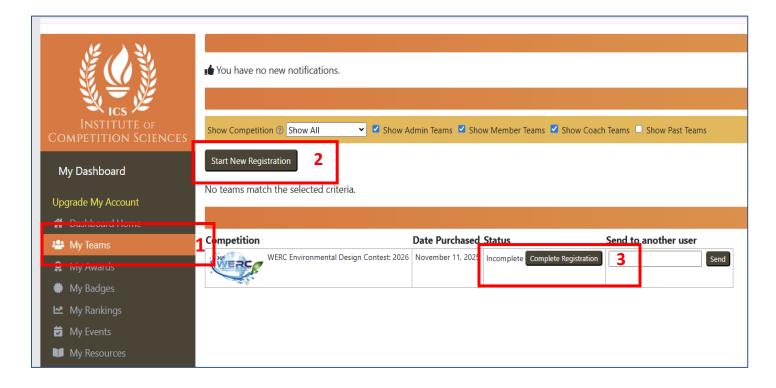


- New Screen: Use dropdown to select First Team, Additional Team, or Additional Member [1]. You can stay in this region until all team members are accounted for. Come back any time to add more team members.
- The fee schedule is explained at the bottom of the page [2].

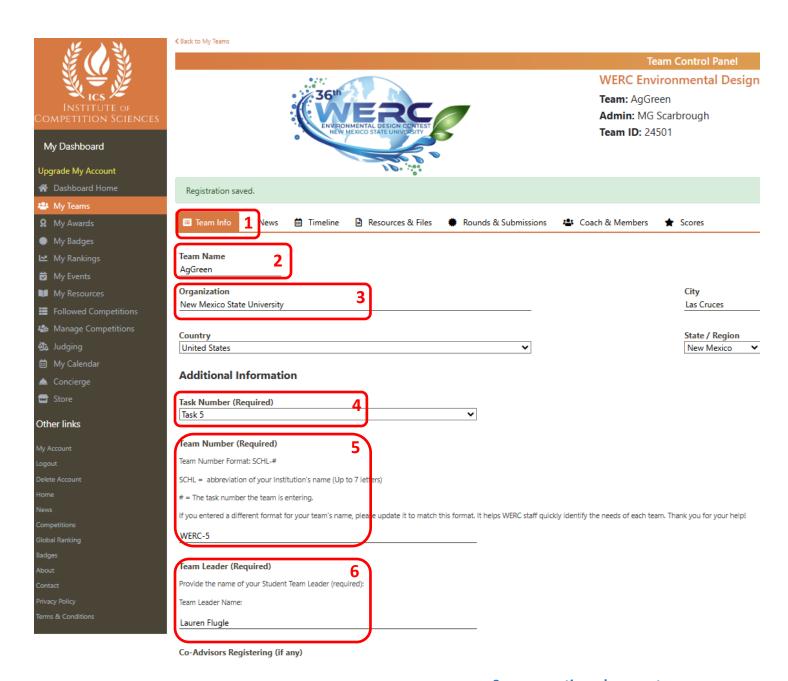


SETTING UP YOUR TEAMS

- **Confirmation email:** Once you have paid for your team(s), you will receive this confirmation email: "To register your team as the coach (or to send the registration to the intended team coach) navigate to "My Teams" at http://www.competitionsciences.org/dashboard.
- Click on the email link to go back to the WERC Registration site.
 - a) Click My Teams sidebar [1].
 - b) Click **Start New Registration** [2]. Note that in the screenshot below, we already registered one team, but we haven't completed their registration.
 - c) You can go back any time to **complete registration** for your team(s) [3].
 - d) Clicking either Start New Registration or Complete Registration will take you to a new screen.

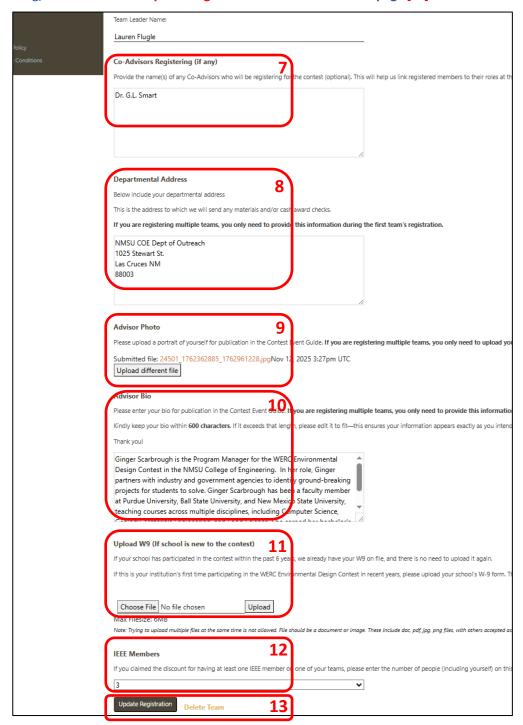


- New Screen: **Team Info Tab** [1] Enter:
 - a) Any **Team Name** you would like [2].
 - b) Full institution Name [3].
 - c) Task Number this team is working on [4].
 - d) Team Number according to convention: SCHL-Task# [5].
 - 1. **SCHL** = School abbreviation (4-7 characters)
 - 2. Task# = Task number the team is entering
 - e) Enter the Student Team Leader's Name [6].

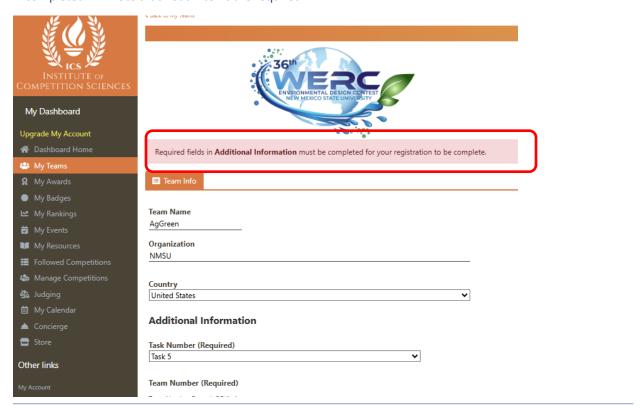

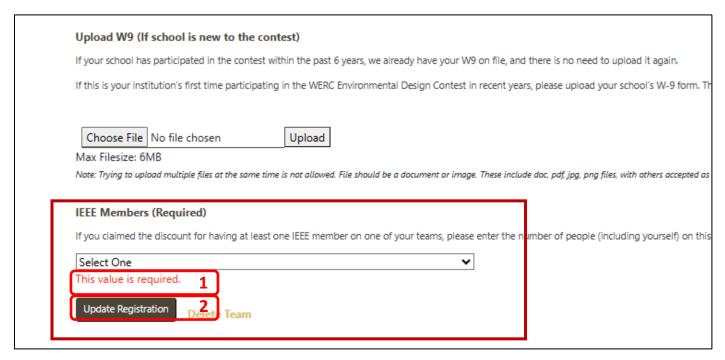
- a) **Team Info Tab, continued:** Enter any Co-Advisors for this team who are coming to the contest. If no Co-Advisors for this team, leave blank [7].
- b) **Enter your Departmental Address.** This is the address to which we will send any samples or cash awards. Only needed for the first team's registration [8].
- c) Upload a photo of you for the Event Guide. Only needed for the first team's registration [9].
- d) Enter your bio. Include research & teaching interests. Only needed for the first team's registration [10].
- e) **Upload your school's W9** <u>only</u> **if your school is new to the contest.** Only needed for the first team's registration [11].
- f) **Enter the number of people on this team who are members of IEEE.** Complete for each team's registration [12].
- g) Be sure to click Update Registration at the bottom of the page [13].



• If you omitted any <u>required</u> items, at the top of the page you will see a pink line "Required fields must be completed....". Note that not all items are required.



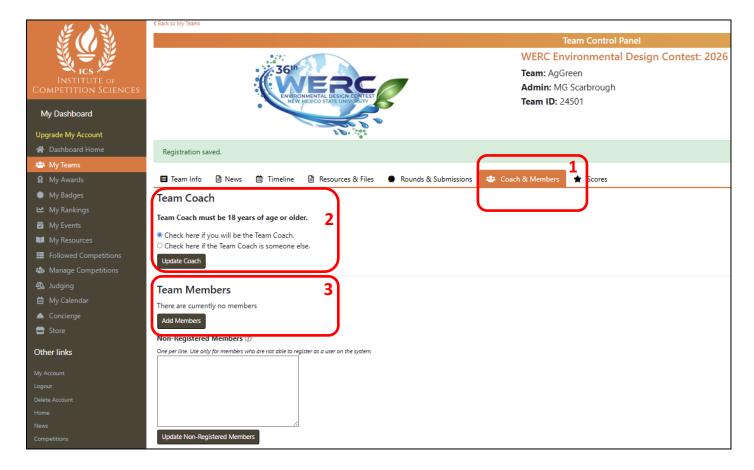

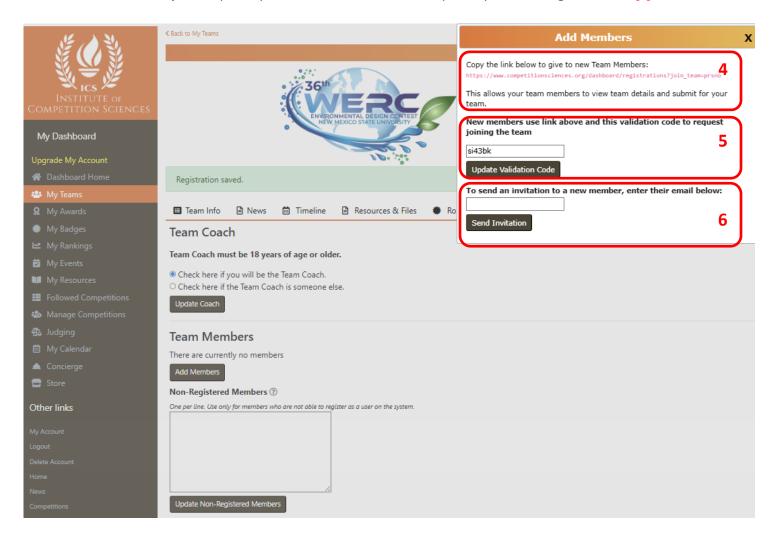

ADDING TEAM MEMBERS

- Add Members to your Team:
 - Click on Coach & Members [1].
 - o Coach: The primary Faculty Advisor. You may switch to a different coach at any time [2].
 - Add Team Members [3]. Click on Add Members.



- An Add Members window will pop up. In the pop-up window:
 - Copy the link and place it in an email to all members of this team [4].
 - Invite Team Members (two options):
 - a. Easiest: copy the validation code (unique to each team) and email it to all students on that team [5].
 - b. Second option: Separately enter the email address of each person you are adding to this team [6].

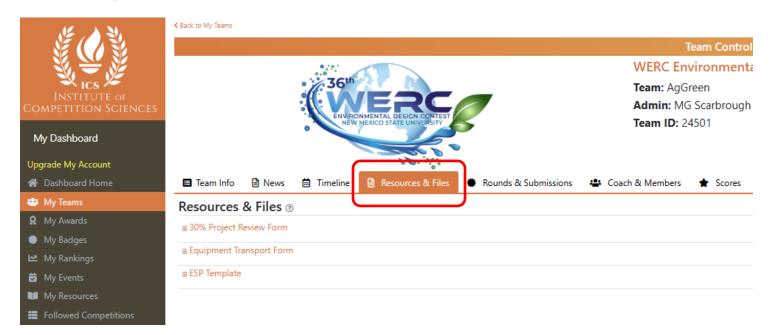


USING THE TEAM SITE: NEWS, TIMELINE, RESOURCES, SUBMISSIONS, SCORES

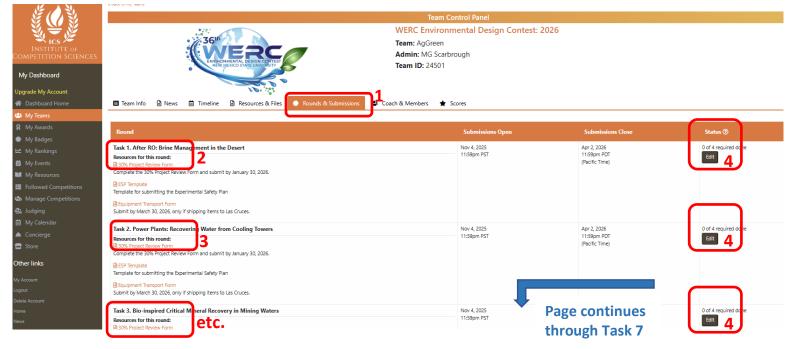
- News: Find all WERC news, such as updated timelines, contest schedules, etc.
- Timeline: Find a calendar of milestones and deliverables.



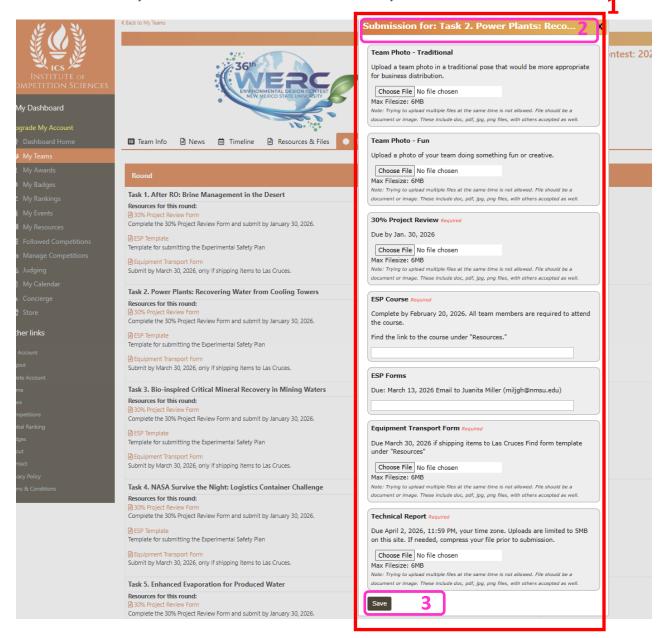
• Resources & Files: Find all forms and templates you will need for submissions as well as other resources related to your task.



- Rounds & Submissions [1]: Your Task is one of the numbered Rounds [2], [3], etc.
 - o Find the same templates and forms within this area as are in the "Resources & Files" tab.
 - o After the registration deadline, you will only be able to see your team's Task plus the Flash Pitch Round.
 - To submit items that are due, such as your team photo or the report: Press Edit [4] under Status.

- To Submit (continued):
 - a. After clicking Edit, a Submission menu will pop up [1]. Make sure it is for the correct Task. [2]
 - b. All but two submissions require file uploads. For the two exceptions:
 - i. Juanita Miller will check for your ESP Course attendance
 - ii. Email your ESP to Juanita Miller.
 - c. After any submission, press Save at the bottom of the Submission Window [3].
 - d. You may come back to the Submission window at any time.
